NOTICE OF A CHANGE IN THE TARIFFS OF SAN MIGUEL POWER
ASSOCIATION, INC.
170 W. 10th Ave., Nucla, CO 81424

You are hereby notified that SAN MIGUEL POWER ASSOCIATION, INC. (SMPA) has approved certain changes to its rate tariff schedule proposed to become effective August 1, 2010.

The approved rate tariff changes will expand our rate offerings and better define the availability of our existing rates to our member-consumers. The changes do not reflect an overall base rate increase. You will only be affected by these changes if you 1) elect to take service under one of the new rate options 2) are currently taking outdoor lighting service under the existing Street Lighting tariff, or 3) are using 20 kW demand per month and are not currently on a demand rate. The rate tariff changes include:

1. Introduction of optional time-of-use (TOU) rate offerings for all general service rates, both demand and non-demand.
2. Introduction of light-emitting diode (LED) outdoor lighting rates.
3. Clarification of the availability of the general service rates based on load size.
4. Provisions for services using 20 kW demand per month, or more, to be placed on a demand rate.

The approved tariff provisions are available for examination and explanation at the Ridgway office located at 720 N. Railroad St., P.O. Box 1150, Ridgway, Colorado 81432 and the Nucla office located at 170 W. 10th Avenue, P.O. Box 870, Nucla, Colorado 81424. They are also available for inspection on the SMPA website at smpa.com.

Anyone who desires to comment about the proposed changes may file written comments and/or complaints at the SMPA offices listed above.

SMPA will hold a public information hearing at 10:00a.m. on July 13, 2010 at the SMPA Nucla office located at 170 W. 10th Avenue, Nucla, Colorado.
